A message from the THINK TEAM!

In 2017, the Think Team were formed at Elderslie Public School. This is a group of students that meet once a week to have a say on what is happening at EPS, both inside and outside of the classrooms. By the end of last year, the Think Team had developed three learner qualities that they thought would help all students to become better learners. These were being reflective, a problem solver and a lifelong learner.

In 2018, the Think Team have introduced everyone to the character, Retro Reflective. Retro reminds us that we need to reflect on our learning and seek feedback so that we can improve. Everyone at Elderslie PS have been making an effort to be reflective and they know that mistakes are proof that we are trying. Our awards at assemblies also demonstrate the amazing work everyone is doing around being reflective learners.

This year, in response to data from students, families and teachers, the Think Team developed the school's 2020 vision setting for the next 3 years. On Monday of Week 8, the Think Team will be hosting a presentation to parents about their journey so far and where they are heading next. This will be an invaluable experience as our school culture and planning is highlighted by what this team have achieved and what they have planned.

More details about this event will be given later in the term. Until then, we encourage all parents to talk to your children about how they are reflective learners. Remind them that mistakes are ok if we learn from them and that if you haven't mastered something, don't give up, seek feedback and reflect on your learning.



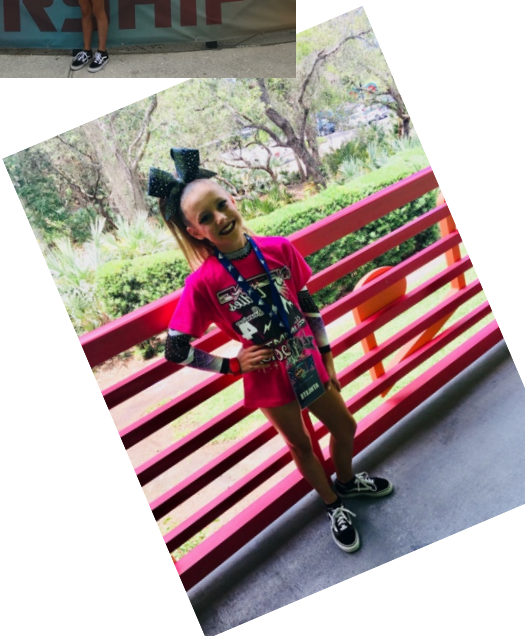
Charlotte C – Cheerleader Superstar!

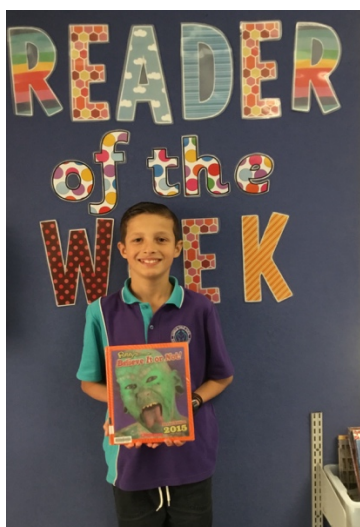
Library News

Good luck representing NSW at the School Sport Australia Championships later in the year.



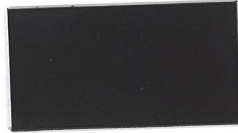

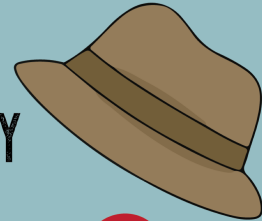
